**COURSE TITLE: High Risk Warrant Operations for Supervisors**

If you are a Commander, Supervisor, or Team Leader of a

- SWAT unit,
- Narcotics Team,
- Gang enforcement unit,
- K-9 Team
- Fugitive Apprehension Team or
- Task Force involved in apprehending dangerous suspects or conducting warrant services, you should attend this course.

**DESCRIPTION:** This 24 hour course is designed for law enforcement Command, Supervisors, Team Leaders, and Tactical Planners. Instruction consists of classroom lecture, legal case law, case studies of tactical incidents, and lessons learned. Emphasis is placed on knowledge and skills necessary to supervise High Risk Warrant operations.

**STUDENT REQUIREMENTS:** Students should be prepared to discuss prior experience in planning High Risk Warrant operations. Each student should bring with them a Lap Top Computer and a sample operational plan.
